To the worshipful Court of Southampton in
Chancery sitting - Humbly complaining
sheweth unto your worship your Complainant
Mathias Boon. That Nicholas Boon late of this
County departed this life sometime in the year 1806
intestate leaving a personal estate amounting
to several hundred dollars. That Allen Boon
brother to the said Nicholas and your Complainant
qualified as administrator of the estate of the said
Nicholas in a very short time after the death
of the said Nicholas. your Complainant here
states that he believes that said Nicholas at the
time of his death was not at all involved in his
circumstances: but so it is may it please your
worship the said Allen has been summoned
to return an account of his transactions
upon said estate and has failed to do so. therefore
it is improper that your Complainant can
speak with accuracy as to the amount of
said estate or as to the amount that he may
be entitled to as one of the heirs of said Nicholas

Complainant
your ~~respondent~~ can only state that he has received
of said Allen about seventy dollars in bonds which
are considered by your Complainant as not worth
any thing and which the said Allen agreed that
he would be ultimately responsible for. He tender
execution whereof and in as much as your Compl:
Complainant is resident in the premises and by the
intervention of this worshipful Court he prays that
said Allen may be made a defendant hereto and
that he be compelled upon his corporal oath to tell
true and perfect answer to make to all and
singular the allegations ^{herein contained.} as well as if
the same were here again repeated and he thereto
again particularly interrogated. and more particu:
larly that he state a fair account of the amount
of the said Nicholas Estate. of the disbursements
made by him. and the amount due to your
Complainant as one of the distributees of the
said Nicholas. and your Complainant prays
that your worship would grant such other and
further relief in the premises as may be just:
intent with justice and Equity and he prays for
Commencement with writ of subpoena uncommanding
