for as much as your orator is remediless at law,  
he prays the intercession of this court -

the said Clements may be made dependant to this  
bill of complaint and that he may on oath discover  
whether the bond on which he obtained the aforesaid  
judgment is not entirely founded upon a gaming  
consideration; and if he denies that the said bond  
was wholly founded on gaming, that he may on  
oath set forth if the said bond was not in part  
founded on a gaming consideration; and lastly  
if he does not owe to your orator the above sum of  
\$250. on account of gaming -

Treaty of 1849.



Mr Arthur Farmer,

Whereas I obtained a  
Judgment against you on the Common  
Law side of the County Court of Middlesex  
-ton, some time previous to April term  
of that Court 1873 at which Court you  
gave Notice on Injunction to stay  
proceedings on the said Judgment, was  
awarded you on your giving bond with  
-in one month thereafter, and whereas  
no such bond was executed by you within  
the said month, notwithstanding which  
the Subpoena of Injunction was in-  
-adventently issued; This is therefore  
to give you notice that I shall  
on the first day of the next May  
term of the said Court move the  
Justices of said Court to petition to  
discharge the said Injunction in con-  
-sequence of its having impermissibly  
issued as aforesaid.
