On the motion of Benjamin L. Walker to open a new road starting from Watts Neck Depot on seaboard and Cranoke Rail Road nearest point to intersect the Haly's Bridge road at or near Benjamin Ellis. Ordered that Howell Harris, Edwin Harris and Nathan N. Thomas be appointed <sup>commissioners</sup> to let out the opening of said road as proposed, provided it does not cost the County more than one hundred and fifty dollars and receive the same completed and make report to Court -

On the motion of Nathan B. Bryant for leave to open a new road from the Meherrin Depot to the Branches Bridge road. The said motion is dismissed -

On the motion of the Court certifies upon satisfactory proof by a white person that Patsy Woodson, free person of mixed blood, resident in this County is not a negro.

Ordered that the Sheriff pay to James D. Bryant ninety six dollars out of any contingent moneys in his hands not otherwise appropriated for extra work &c to the Jail -

Allen Cowards, James W. Murfee, Jas D. Bryant, W<sup>m</sup> C. Gay, Henry Dow, Charles S. Higubart, Elijah Logner, Davis Barrett, Egan Bryant, James Harris, Mark A. James & James E. Peters are appointed Overseers of the Poor for the County of Southampton for the next three years, and It is ordered that they be summoned to the next Court to qualify

Ordered that the Court be adjourned to the first day of the next term
