This Cause this day came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read in the report of the commissioners made at the last term of this Court, to which report no exceptions having been filed was argued by counsel: On consideration whereof, the Court confirming said reports, doth adjudge, order and decree that the same be held firm, inevitable and binding between the parties forever, and that the costs of this cause be proportionally borne by the parties.

On the motion of Benjamin Washington, who made oath and together with Robert Stephenson, John Stephenson & Allen Stephenson his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Peggy Washington dec'd in due form.

Jones & Thomas E. Joyner, being returned & executed, and the said Perfor failing to appear, upon consideration whereof, the Court doth order that the lands of John D. Peyton be transferred to the road of Thomas E. Joyner.

On the motion of Geo. Moore & A. McNeill, who came in this Court as securities for Jesse Cobb & Geo. Gardner, executors of Jesse Gardner dec'd for the faithful discharge of their office in trust as executors aforesaid, It is ordered that the said Jesse Cobb & Geo. Gardner be summoned here to the next term of this Court, to show cause if they can why they should not be required to give a new bond for the faithful discharge of the duties of their office in trust as executors aforesaid according to Law.
