

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County,
held at the Courthouse thereof on Monday, the 19th day of August 1861,
Present, Samuel R. Kello, presiding Justice, Thomas J. Perkins,
John E. Buzge, Jurors

The Clerk this day returned a list of all writings admitted to record in this
Court during and since the last preceding term ended Chapter 134 of the
Acts of Virginia, which list having been read to the Court in
accordance to his duty, with minutes of the proceedings of the day and
is as follows, to-wit:

Deed of Benjamin and Sarah, dated 21st January 1861, from Wm. C. Cobb
Commissioner to Sarah R. Dutton, Conveying land, was admitted
to record, July 15th 1861.

Deed of Benjamin and Sarah, dated 18th March 1861, from Wm. C. Cobb
to James S. Blomble, Conveying land, was admitted to record
August 9th 1861.

On the motion of James Mills it is ordered that E. W. Maffington be
appointed trustee in the place of Wm. V. Edwards dec'd and carry
into execution a deed of trust executed by Thomas Edwards to the
said Edwards for the benefit of James Mills on the 29th day
of February 1844, now of record in the office of this Court.

On the motion of Wm. A. Thomas who made oath and together with
Thomas Hall & George W. Vick, his sureties, (who testified on
us to their sufficiency) returned into and acknowledged and admitted
the sum of four thousand Dollars, considered according to law, be-
lieved to be granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on
the estate of Robert Fairfax dec'd in due form.

Ordered that John Doss, Samuel Kimbrell, L. A. Lusher, Jack Johnson
and John M. Kimbrell, or any three of them being sworn for the purpose,
do appraise all the goods and chattels of Robert Fairfax dec'd
that may be produced to them and make due return of the
same.

The last Will and Testament of Sarah M. A. Ramsey was
this day proved by the oaths of Samuel Dwyer and Joseph W. Vick,
George, two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and more behooved
and Joseph W. Vick, claimed the execution therein named having refused
to take upon himself the burden of the execution of the said
will, did no person a petitioner for Administration with the will
annexed thereto, it is therefore ordered that George W. Vick
Sheriff of this County take into his hands the said estate
to be administered according to law.
