 besides his costs Therefore It is considered by the court that the
 plaintiff recover agt the said defendant five hundred pounds
 of tobacco the debt in the declaration mentioned one moiety
 thereof to our said lord the king to aid for the better support
 of this government and the contingent charges thereof and
 the other moiety to the plaintiff to aid for his proper use and
 that the plaintiff recover agt the said defendant his damages
 aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed and his costs by twain
 about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant
 in every pt.

 part and William Beard of the other part and the memorandum
 of livery of seisin theron except theron endorsed were acknowledged
 by the said Joshua and ordered to be recorded

An indenture of feoffment between Francis Jones of Albrington
