that he pay the costs of this prosecution

Upon the presentment of the Grand Jury agst John Willens for
not keeping his road in repair The said John having been
duly summoned appeared and offering nothing in excuse
It is considered by the Court that he forfeit and pay to the
churchwardens of this parish fifteen shillings and that he
pay the costs of this prosecution

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of William
Heatfield decd was returned and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Thomas Williamson the builder of the
bridge over Black Water at Broad Water It is ordered that
the Treasurer pay him the proportion due from this county
of seventy five pounds the consideration for the same he
having entered into bond agreeable to the rules of this Court

On the motion of Joshua Pitton by his attorney against the
sheriff of this county who hath levied an execution agst the
estate of Samuel Willis on a judgment obtained in this
Court by the said Joshua agst the said Willis and failed
bring the same into Court and the said sheriff having had
legal notice of this It is considered by the Court that the
said Pitton recover agst the said sheriff eight pounds
