The last will and testament of Giles Snellley ^{deceased} with a codicil thereto annexed were presented in court by Joshua Whitray the executor therein named proved by the oaths of William Haynes and John Lawrence two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said executor certificate is granted him for obtaining probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon he with Lewis Joyner Israel Joyner Benjamin Denson entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £1000 for the said Joshua's due and faithful adition of the said decedent's estate and performance of his will

Ordered that William Haynes Benjamin Westra - Bennett Hoffman and Henry Joyner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Giles Snellley ^{deceased} & return the appraisement to the court

An indenture of feoffment between George Jordan and Patience his wife of the one part and George Wood of the other part and acknowledgment of livery of seisin thereon endorsed was acknowledged by the said George and Patience the being first privily examined as the law directs / ordered to be recorded
