Upon the presentment of the grand jury against John Holden for not
listing one tithe The said John having been duly summoned appearing
and offering nothing in excuse It is considered by the court that he
forfeit and pay to the churchwardens of this parish five hundred
pounds of tobacco according to the act of assembly in that case
made and provided and that he pay the costs of this prosecution

Upon the presentment of the grand jury against Benjamin Holden
for not listing one tithe The said Benjamin having been duly
summoned appearing and offering nothing in excuse It is considered
by the court that he forfeit and pay to the churchwardens of this
parish five hundred pounds of tobacco according to the act of assembly
in that case made and provided that he pay the costs of this
prosecution

Hardy Hennis is by the court appointed to execute the office of constable
in this county and was sworn accordingly

Ordered that Mary Bap widow and relict of John Johnson be summoned
to appear at the next court and declare whether she will administer on her
said husbands estate

On the complaint of John Bly It is Ordered that Hardy Johnson be
summoned to appear at the next court and answer the complaint of the
said Bly for breach of the peace

Ordered that the court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 o'clock
