recover against the said defendant one hundred and eight pounds, the debt

this behalf expended and the said defendant in money &c But this judg-
ment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of ten
pounds together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate
of five per centum from the 20 day of July 1751. to the time of payment.
