discharged

An indenture of feoffment between Arthur Taylor of the one
part and Thomas Turner of the other part was proved by
the oaths of John Wilkinson William Byrum of Benjamin
Byrum the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
John Cullis by the court appointed surveyor of the highway in
the town of Samuel Seward

Samuel Blon Nicholas Mager and William Haynes are by
the court recommended as fit and able persons to serve as justices in
the commission of the peace

Ordered that the several persons take the list of tithes in their
respective precincts as last year except Jope Browne in the town
of Alldington Jones

Upon the petition of William Jordan admor of John Jordan
decd assignee of Benjamin Simons Sheriff of Hampton against
Richardson Piggan & Samuel Seward for four pounds four shillings
and interest due by bond This day came the plaintiff by his
attorney and the defendants having been duly summoned & served
with a copy of the petition and not appearing On the Motion
of the said plaintiff It is Considered by the court that he recover
against the said defendants the said four pounds twelve shillings together
with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five
per centum per annum from the 27 day of December 1755 to the time
of payment and his costs by him in this behalf expended

The petition of Arthur Davis against Benjamin Tucker is
dismissed

The petition of Simon Barrett against Joseph Norton
is dismissed being agreed by the parties
