Ordered that James Ridley Howell Edmunds and John Person gent or any two of them do agree in conjunction with the persons appointed by Brunswick county for building a bridge over metem river called Donaldsons bridge and make report thereof to the court

An additional account of the administration of the estate of William Hatfield deed was returned by the persons appointed to settle the same and ordered to be recorded

An indenture of feoffment between Robert Dean of the one part and Thomas Pyland of the other part and the memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Thomas Clifton Amos Garris and John Scott witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that Peter Butts Benjamin Simmons and Mordgon Jones do view the repairs lately made to the prison of this county and report if the same is done according to the agreement entered into by the undertakers

James Ridley gent having first taken the usual oaths to his Majesty's person and government took & subscribed the abjuration oath and test was given a justice of the peace & justice in chancery

John Person produced a commission appointing him a captain of foot in this county and having taken the usual oaths to his Majesty's person and government and taken and subscribed the abjuration oath and subscribed the test was sworn in his office accordingly.
