Benjamin Simmons and Charles Briggs having first taken the usual oaths to his majestys person and government and taken and subscribed the abjuration oath and test were on the Motion of Albington Jones sworn his under sheriff

An indenture of feoffment between Richardson Peggan of the one part and Benjamin Wood of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Benjamin Simmons Thomas Langley and William Kelley witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten O'clock
