Upon the petition of Joseph Denson against Joseph Powell for two pounds due by note of hand This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing On the Motion of the plaintiff It is Considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said two pounds together with interest for the same to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 20th day of July 1757 till paid this costs by him in this behalf expended
