Byrnum will do it for him and thereupon the said defendant by his attorney saving to himself all advantage of exception as well to the plaintiffs writ as to the declaration prays and has leave to impeach till the next court

The last will and testament of William Spence was presented in court by Simon Turner the executor therein named proved by the oath of John Howlings and James Bap witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of the said executor who made oath according to Law - certificate is granted him for obtaining approval thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Simon together with Henry Gaffon his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £500 for the said Simons due and faithful admon of the said decedents estate and performance of his will
