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Ordered that William Bejon John Wilkinson John Edwards & Henry Crafford or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Jones deceased and return the appraisement to the court. The last will and testament of Walter Gilliam deceased was presented in court by Sarah Gilliam the executrix therein named proved by the oaths of Burnwell Gilliam and Arthur Foster two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted to him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Sarah together with Thomas Westbrooke and Elias Foot his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £500 for the said Sarah due and faithful admon on the said decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Gilliam Charles Barham Benjamin Barham and Thomas Scott or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Walter Gilliam deceased and return the appraisement to the court.

Ordered that Benjamin Cochs hands be added to the precinct whereof Miles Cary is surveyor.

On the Motion of William Simmons who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John Simmons deceased giving security whereupon the said William together with Benjamin Simmons his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of £5000 for the said William due and faithful admon on the said decedents estate.

Ordered that Benjamin Clements Benjamin Clements junr Ambrose Williams and Richard Pirby junr or any three of them do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Simmons deceased and return the appraisement to the court.

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Clifton junr of the one part and James Moore of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Thomas and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the treasurer pay Robert Richs the sum of two pounds sixteen shillings for repairing the prison.

Ordered that Peter Butts Benjamin Simmons and Miles Cary gent examine the clerks office see if Pirbys time is expired for keeping Simmons bridge in repair if it is they are to let it to repair or rebuild at their discretion if otherwise they are to give the said Pirby notice that he repair the said bridge immediately.

Ordered that Benjamin Simmons let the repair of the Rawon Bridge.
