Ordered that Micajah Edwards Henry Thomas John Thomas and Thomas Gray or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Henry Blunt deceased and return the appraisement to the court.

An indenture of feoffment between Christopher Foster of the one part and John Westbrooke of the other part and a memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Christopher and ordered to be recorded.

An inventory & appraisement of the estate of Jane Smith deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Benjamin Denjon guardian to Celia Whitehead orphan of Arthur Thibault returned an account of his guardianship of the said orphans estate to which he made oath and the same was examined and approved of by the court and ordered to be recorded.

On the Motion of John Lewis It is Ordered that he be added to Howell Edmunds list of tithe.
