 certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration on the said
 John Scotts estate whereupon the said John Munday together with
 Joshua Claud his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
 penalty of £2000. for the said John due and faithful admon on the said John
 Scotts estate

Ordered that William Payson David Edmunds Henry Harris and
 Jacob Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the
 peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate
 of John Scott deed and return the appraisement to the court
 William Haynes gent having first taken the usual oaths to his Majesty
 person and government taken and subscribed the abjuration oath which
 was sworn a justice of the peace and judge in chancery

Timothy Thorne is by the court appointed guardian to Thomas Jewell
 orphan of Thomas Jewell deed giving security whereupon the said
 Timothy together with Mijajah Edwards his security entered into of admon
 their bond in the penalty of £2000 for the said Timothy's guardianship of the
 said orphans estate and indemnifying the court

Ordered that the churchwardens bind out Lucretia, Elvira, and Mervin
 children of Pall West according to law
