

Upon the petition of Thomas Tistur against John Cobb for pounds & interest from the 17th Sept 1708 till paid this day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said sum of four pounds & interest as aforesaid & his costs in this behalf expended & in full acknowledges satisfaction for £. 10

On the motion of W^m Darden a witness for Thomas Tistur against John Cobb it is ordered that the said Tistur pay him one hundred & thirty four pounds of tobacco for two days attendance on this court & travelling fourteen miles triu & returning according to Law

On the motion of James Turner a witness for Tho^s. Tistur against John Cobb It is ordered that the said Tistur pay him one hundred & thirty four pounds of tobacco for two days attendance on this court & travelling fourteen miles triu & returning according to Law

On the motion of Moses Darden a witness for Thomas Tistur against John Cobb it is ordered that the said Tistur pay him sixty seven pounds of tobacco for one day attendance on this Court & riding fourteen miles one & returning according to Law

Upon the petition of Amos Newsom against Hewit Drew for two pounds five shillings due by account This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard It is considered that the said petition be dismissed

On the motion of Jerumiah Drew a witness for Amos Newsom against Hewit Drew it is ordered that the said Amos pay him seventy five pounds of tobacco for three days attendance on this court according to Law

Upon the petition of Edmund Day J^r against John Barron for one pound eight shillings & three pence due by account This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the defendant having been duly summoned & served with a copy of the petition & not appearing & the petitioner having proved his account by his oath It is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the J^r defendant the said sum of one pound eight & three pence & his costs by him in this behalf expended

On the motion of Nathan Harris and Thomas Faircloth witnesses for Edmund Day J^r against John Barron it is ordered that the J^r. Day pay them respectively twenty five pounds of tobacco for one day attendance each on this Court according to Law
