Ordered that William Bart, Jethro Darden, John Bishop and Etheldred Everitt many times of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county, do appraise in current money the slaves, if any, and personal estate of Etheldred Warren decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

Lazarus Cook, James Maget and Henry Pillar produced each of them a commission from the Governor of this commonwealth appointing them Captains of the militia in this county, and qualified thereto according to law.

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Jeremiah Drens decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Robert Carr guardian to Robert Vaper orphan of Nathan Vaper decd. returned an account of the produce of his wards estate, of the sales and dispositions of such produce, and of the disbursements, which was examined by the court found properly and fairly stated, sworn to by the said guardian and ordered to be recorded.

Present Roy^r. Blunt, Absent George Gurley Gent.

On the motion of Thomas Lane and for sufficient reasons appearing to the court his negroes Dick and Frank are exempted from payment of taxes, parish and county levies in future.

Ordered that Richard Tullio and Samuel Tullio examine, state and settle the accounts of Lewis Joiner jun^r with the parish of Nottoway, and make report thereof to this court.

Edward Branch orphan of John Branch decd. is for sufficient reasons appearing to the court exempted from payment of taxes, poor rates and county levies during his disability.

Thomas Ridley produced a commission from the Governor of this commonwealth appointing him a Colonel of the militia in this county, and qualified thereto according to law.

Abbridgton Jones produced a commission from the Governor of this commonwealth appointing him a Lieutenant Colonel in the militia of this county, and qualified thereto according to law.

Samuel Tullio produced a commission from the Governor of this commonwealth appointing him Major in the militia of this county, and qualified thereto according to law.

Absent John Simmons. Present Thomas Ridley Gentleman

John Simmons produced a commission from the Governor of this commonwealth appointing him a Captain of the light company in the militia of this county and qualified thereto according to law.

Sharr Barnes who stands bound by recognizance to appear here this day to answer the complaint of Johnson against him for a breach of the peace appeared accordingly and no person appearing to prosecute it is ordered that he be discharged.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till court in course.
