aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed and his costs by him about his suits in this
behalf expended. To be levied of the goods and chattels of the said decedent in the hands
of the defendant to be administered if so much thereof he hath if not then the costs to
be levied of the defendants own proper goods and chattels. And the said defendant in
