John Stephenson late of the county of Southampton and parish of Stottaway who stands charged with felony entering the barn of Lewis St. Branch on the 18th of December last and taking therefrom a bag of Tobacco the property of Orson Branch was this day set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid (The court summoned for his examination not having met) and thereupon Orson Branch a witness for the bond was sworn and sworn touching the premises - The court after hearing the testimony of all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for said offence at the next Superior court to be holden for this county & thereupon it is ordered that he be remanded to jail -

Be it remembered that Orson Branch here in court acknowledged himself indebted unto His Excellency Mr. B. Giles Governor or chief magistrate of this colony & his Successor in office for the time being in the sum of \$333:33/3 cents to be levied off his goods & chattels lands & tenements to the said Governor for the use of the bond. Not upon this condition that if shall personally appear before Judge of our Superior court in Southampton at the court house on the first day of the next term by 10 o'clock of that day then & there to give such testimony as he knows or believes on behalf of John Stephenson who stands charged with felony & shall not depart thence without leave of the court
