This Indenture made this Twenty first day of February in the  
year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred & three between William  
Wester of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Mary Wester of the  
County & state of the other, Witnesses, that for the love and affection  
which I bear to my daughter Mary Wester and for and in consideration of  
the sum of one hundred and twenty money of Virginia to me in hand paid  
by the said Mary Wester before the enrolling and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, and my self to be therewith fully  
satisfied contented and well have granted, bargained, sold, Alien Confeff  
and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain & sell Alien Confeff  
& forever confirm unto her the said Mary Wester her heirs and assigns  
forever One certain Tract or parcel of Land, situate lying and being  
in the said County of Southampton on the south side of black water  
River and bounded as follows (Viz) Beginning at a pine standing  
on the ~~west~~ side Boom Branch on Williams H Barkers land  
thence North sixty five degrees East ninety three pole to a white  
oak thence South thirty one degrees East thirteen pole to a white  
oak thence North East one hundred and sixty two poles to a white  
oak thence running a west course along a line of marked trees to a  
pine a corner tree thence a South East course along a line of  
unmarked trees to the beginning Containing Sixty two Acres  
To have & to hold the said bargain and purchase of with  
all the appurtenances thereto belonging to her the said Mary Wester  
her heirs and assigns forever and I the said William Wester for my  
self my heirs Executors and administrators will warrant and defend  
the said bargained premises, against the lawful claims of all and  
every other person whatsoever, unto her the said Mary Wester her  
heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof I the said Wm  
Wester have hereunto <sup>set</sup> my hand and affixed my seal the day and date  
first above written
