This Indenture made the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> the thirteenth  
 eight hundred and three Between William Wollens & Mary his wife  
 of the County of Southampton & Newtown Parish of the one Part and  
 Westward Wollens of the same County & Parish of the other Part  
 Witnesseth that he the said William Wollens & Mary his wife  
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds  
 Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid as a before the making  
 and delivery of these Presents the receipts whereof the said William  
 Wollens & Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge and theirs of  
 Receipt and discharge the said Westward Wollens his heirs Executors  
 and Assigns by these presents hath the said William Wollens & Mary his  
 wife doth grant bargain sell out & by these presents doth give  
 bargain sell out unto the said Westward Wollens or his heirs & Assigns  
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County  
 of Parish of aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and fifty  
 four more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a  
 Hickory at the head of a branch called the main branch there  
 by a line of mark to Thomas Trotter line to a Corner tree a piece  
 of Oak Wollens line and by the said Wollens line to a hollow tree and  
 down the said hole to the mouth of the large branch called Crab hole  
 thence up the main branch of the run of Oak branch to a black gum  
 a corner tree of Charles Wollens line thence crossing flow Thomas  
 branch in Charles Wollens line to the Tarkell branch to a black  
 a corner tree of Charles Wollens line thence up the run of Oak branch  
 to a live Oak a corner tree thence along a line of a corner tree of  
 Charles Wollens to the draw branch thence to the beginning of  
 the brown way Water comes from a corner tree of Charles Wollens
