Lenox

This Indenture made this the thirtieth day of April in the  
year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and seven between  
Thomas Wooten & Mary his wife of the County of Southampton  
of the one part and Henry Lenox of the County of Spotsylvania  
of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Wooten  
Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety  
Five Dollars Lawful money of Virginia to them in hand  
paid by the said Henry Lenox before the unsealing and delivery of  
these presents the receipt whereof they the said Henry Wooten &  
Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof & of every part  
& parcel thereof doth fully, clearly and absolutely acquit & exonerate  
and discharge the said Henry Lenox his heirs, executors & assigns by  
these presents - and for divers other goods & considerations then then  
unto moving they the said Thomas Wooten and Mary his wife  
hath granted, bargained & sold, Alien, enfeoffed & confirmed  
unto Henry Lenox his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract  
or parcel of Land containing eighteen acres more or less being  
apart of a Tract of Land given the said Thomas Wooten by his  
father and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a  
pole and cleft between the said Lenox and Minto and Millers  
Dut. Thence South along the D. Wellons line to a red oak adjacent  
made a corner between the said Wooten & Lenox. Thence west  
along a new line of marked trees to a white oak by the side  
of the road thence North along the said road to a red oak in  
the said Lenoxs line thence East along the said Lenoxs line to the  
beginning - To have and to hold the Lands hereby conveyed  
and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned &  
intended to be hereby granted with the reversion and necessary  
Remainder & remainder, rents and services of the premises and  
all the estate right title Interest claim and demands of them  
the said Thomas Wooten & Mary his wife their heirs & assigns  
of in or to the said Land and premises, every part thereof and  
the appurtenances herein before mentioned unto the said  
Henry Lenox his heirs & assigns forever & the said Thomas  
Wooten and Mary his wife for themselves & their heirs &  
from all and every other person or persons whatsoever
