This Indenture made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of February Anno domini One thousand eight hundred and Eight between Zebulon Lewis and Rebeckah his wife formerly Rebeckah Hannip of the one part and Humphrey Drowny of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Zebulon Lewis and Rebeckah his wife formerly Rebeckah Hannip, for and in consideration of the sum of sixty three pounds Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Humphrey Drowny at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and then fore and from every part thereof do acquit and discharge the said Humphrey Drowny, having granted bargained and sold, aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed, unto by these presents do and each of us doth grants bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirms unto the said Lewis and Rebeckah his wife right title Interest claim property or demand which they or each of them have in a certain tract of lands or its appurtenances laying in the County of Southampton on the South side of the three Creeks Commonly called the great Water tract, Containing by a late Survey six hundred & seventy four Acres being the same land mentioned in the will of Amos Hannip dead as containing & Twenty Acres
