John Carr and his wife Sarah Carr and Jimey McMichael of the
one part and Priscilla Bynum of the other part. and all the
other part and all the County of Southampton & State of Virginia
Witnesseth that the said John Carr and Sarah Carr (his wife) and
Jimey McMichael for and in consideration of the sum of twenty
two pounds to the said John Carr and Sarah his wife and Jimey
McMichael well and paid at or before the creating and delivery of
these presents by the said Priscilla Bynum, the receipt whereof
the said John Carr and Sarah his wife and Jimey McMichael
doth hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold and confirmed and
by these presents doth bargain, sell alien and deliver unto the said
Priscilla Bynum her heirs &c a certain tract or parcel of land
lying in the County of Southampton & containing eighty acres by a
late survey, and bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a
white oak a line tree of John Johnson on the South at house corner
thence a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of Fainlocks
thence a line of marked trees to a branch in
