This Indenture made this 24th day of April in the

year of our Lord 1809 Between Samuel Whitehead of the one part and Lewis Worrell all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Samuel Whitehead for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Worrell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Samuel Whitehead hath granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever all his interest title, claims and demand, of in and to his own part or portion of the Lands of formerly the property of John Whitehead his father with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging together with the houses, ways waters & water courses. To have and to hold the said undivided part or portion of the Lands of the said Samuel Whitehead of father of the aforesaid Samuel Whitehead to him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said
