Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten between John Mage and Mully his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and William and Peter of the County of Sussex of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Mage and Mully his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty five pounds to them in hand paid by the said William Peter the receipt whereof is acknowledged do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Peter one tract or parcel of Land being and lying in the County of Southampton and on the South side of Millway or more bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine in Wilson Newsons mill pond on the Hornt Swamp dividing between Queen Myrick Bay Water and Sally Blow from thence by a piece of marked tree dividing between said Blow and Queen Myrick and Howell Myrick from thence by a line of marked dividing between the said
