This Indenture made this 19th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven between Nathl Pierce & Priscilla his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part, and William Briggs, William Kitchner John H. Pond, Peter Pond Robert Mellons, Edwin Drake & Henry Briggs Trustees, in trust for the use and purposes herein after mentioned, all of the County of Southampton of the other parts, Witnesseth that the said Nathl Pierce and Priscilla as his wife hath given granted, released, confirmed conveyed and by these presents doth give grant release confirm and convey unto them the said William Briggs, William Kitchner John H. Pond Peter Pond Robert Mellons Edwin Drake and Henry Briggs and their Successors all their right and title in and to one acre of land laid off out of the tract of land whereon the said Nathl Pierce man being lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows, beginning at a corner said Pierce's line thence North thirty yards to a person in the thence South thirty yards east One hundred and sixty yards to a red oak tree, for the purpose herein after mentioned with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
