At a court held for the County of
 John T. Richardson Southampton the day of May 1833 this
 Roberton Capelle Indenture was proved by the Oath of John
 William Sharp T. Richardson and Roberton Capelle two

of the witnesses hereof and continued until at
 a court held for said County the 16th day of September 1834
 This Indenture was further proved by the Oath of William Sharp
 another Witness thereof after having been before proved by two other witnesses
 and read as follows

This Indenture made this 5th day of May one thousand
 eight hundred and eleven Between Timothy Atkinson of the first
 part, John Mcquharb of the second part, and William Bailey
 of the third part Witnesseth, by their presents, that the said Timothy
 Atkinson for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to him
 in hand paid by the said William Bailey, the receipt whereof he
 the said Timothy Atkinson doth hereby acknowledge, hath, granted
 bargained, and sold, aliened, released and Confirmed, by these
 presents doth grant, confirm and sell alien, release unto the said
 William Bailey, his heirs and assigns forever, all the Plantation
 tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
 (said Parish of Rottoway) which tract or parcel of land and plant-
 ation, the said Timothy Atkinson now lies and containing by
 estimation 335 Acres more or less Bounded by the lanes of said Mcquharb
 Simon Boyson, & on the other part by the most ancient, known and
 reputed bounds of the said tract or parcel of land, and also the
 reversion and reversions remainder, and remainders, rents and issues
 thereof, and of every part & parcel thereof. To have and to hold,
 the said tract or parcel of land, and Premises, with the appurtenances
 thereunto belonging unto William Bailey, his heirs and assigns forever
 to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William
