This Indenture made this 29th day of June one thousand
eight hundred and fourty between Lewis P Hart of the County of
Southampton of the first part and Colles Fletcher of the same
County of the second part and James Rochelle of the same County of
the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said James Rochelle
became surety for William Hart for the sum of three thousand
and fifty dollars by bill special bearing date the 21st day of October
1842 due to John White and the said Lewis P Hart being willing to
secure and save harmless the said James Rochelle and for the further
consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Colles
Fletcher the receipt whereof the said Lewis P Hart doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted bargain and sold and by their presents
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Colles Fletcher his heirs
executors and administrators one certain tract or parcel of land lying
in the county of Southampton and parish of Saint Peter containing
by estimation twenty acres and one fourth of an acre it being a tract
or parcel of land which William Hart purchased of John White
