 said County, with Ellis aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth
 to Granted that the said Kinchen Selks for and in consideration of
 1st day of Four hundred and forty six dollars to me in hand paid by the
 said James Ellis, who receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 the said Kinchen Selks have bargained, granted, sold, aliened,
 released and confirmed unto the said James Ellis, to him and
 his heirs forever, and certain tract, parcel or piece of Land,
 situated lying, and being in the County of Southampton, on the
 North side of Nottoway River, containing by a best estimation,
 (or survey) two hundred and seventy eight acres, and one half acre,
 be it the same more or less as bounded as follows (Viz) by the land
 of Michael Ellis, Nathaniel Barkans, George Bolts, Anne
 Sebrell, Michael Ellis aforesaid, Anne Hoster, River Barker,
 and Michael Ellis as before begun at, To have and to hold
