# THIS INDENTURE

made this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and eighth years (Humphrey Drawing, Jesse Clark and David Westbrook of the County of Southampton as commissioners appointed by the said court to sell the land of Sally Mors as commissioners appointed by the said court to sell the land of Sally Mors &c. of the one part and Humphrey Drawing of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty Dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Humphrey Drawing the receipt whereof they the said Commissioners doth hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold, aliened, confirmed &c. by these presents bargain, sell, give, confirm unto the said Humphrey Drawing a certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying and being in the County of Southampton bounded by the land of the said Drawing Thomas Rishley the nephew of Henry Barrow dec'd and the down land of Suteeth Johnson containing thirty acres by late survey To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Humphrey Drawing his heirs and assigns forever and they the said Commissioners the said tract or parcel of Land to the said Humphrey his heirs and assigns against them the said court and their heirs and assigns forever defined by these presents.
