This Indenture

made and executed this 3rd day of February in the year of our late eight hundred and nineteen. Between Thomas H. Collier of the first part, Edwin Lewis and Richard B. Day of the second part, and Aubin Middleton of the third all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witness that whereas the said Edwin Lewis and Richard B. Day have become common bail for the said Thomas Collier in the following fixtures of debt to wit one in favor of Thomas Pritton for one hundred and thirty four Dollars and twenty five Cents due by promissory note, and other in favor of Edmund Turner assignee of J. P. Cook for the sum of twenty dollars due by single specialty, and one other in favor of Lewis Capell for the benefit of George Simpson for the sum of forty two dollars and fifty cents due by single bill. And the said Thomas H. Collier being willing and desirous to secure and save harmless the aforesaid Edwin Lewis and Richard B. Day his common bail as aforesaid. Now this Indenture therefore further Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid but more especially for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him the said Thomas H. Collier in hand paid by the said Aubin Middleton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Aubin Middleton his heirs assigns executors administrators forever three certain negroes known by the names of Charles, Ned and Molly To have and to hold unto the said Aubin Middleton his heirs &c upon this special trust confidence that if the said Edwin Lewis and Richard B. Day shall suffer or be liable to suffer on account of their suretyship aforesaid then and in that case it may and shall be lawful for the said Aubin Middleton at the request of either of the parties aforesaid or their legal representatives the maker or makers of the aforesaid negroes Charles Ned Molly or a sufficiency of them offer cash after giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale to pay and satisfy the aforesaid debts interest
