Whereas Adam Woodford by his certain Deed of Mortgage bearing date the 29th July in the year of our Lord 1808 among other things conveyed to a certain Jordan Tinson a tract of land lying in Northway Parish in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and four acres and bounded according to the known and reported bounds thereof being a tract of land purchased by the said Adam Woodford from a certain Howell Briggs to secure the payment of 1000 pounds and eighty dollars and four cents or thereabouts the first day of October next thereafter and whereas the said Jordan Tinson afterwards departed this life leaving a last will and testament appointing a certain Joseph Tinson his executor who qualified according to law and the said Joseph Tinson afterwards departed this life leaving a last will and testament appointing a certain Samuel Davis his executor who qualified according to law and whereas the money secured to be paid by the said Deed of mortgage with the accruing interest thereon hath been fully paid and satisfied to the said Davis executor as aforesaid Now therefore this Indenture made this 13th day of January in the year 1819 between the said Samuel Davis executor of Joseph Tinson who was executor of Jordan Tinson of the first part and the said Adam Woodford of the second part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Davis executor as aforesaid for and in consideration of the premises hath released and confirmed and by these presents doth release, ratify and confirm unto the said Adam Woodford his heirs and assigns the before mentioned tract of land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the before named tract
