This Indenture made the 30th day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty three year of the Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part, Joshua & Edwin Blount of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia father party, Witnesseth that the said Joshua & Edwin Blount for consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said John Rivers at a before the executing and signing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Rivers his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton containing by a late survey Twenty four acres more or less adjoining the lands of Joshua Blount the lands of Edwin Blount and the land belonging to the estate of Henry Parner dec^d. To have and to hold the said land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said John Rivers his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joshua & Edwin Blount for himself his heirs and assigns the said land with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Rivers his heirs & assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Joshua & Edwin Blount his heirs and assigns and against the claim or claims of all & every other person or persons whatsoever shall, will, do warrant and forever defend by these presents his witness whereof the said Joshua & Edwin Blount have hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written.
