 right and full power and authority to grant convey and  
 give the said land and premises and wrap and thereof  
 unto the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns. Further  
 doth Covenant promise and agree to and with the said  
 Richard Harrison that he the said Benjamin Harrison  
 and his heirs shall and will from time to time and at  
 all times forever hereafter at the request of said Richard  
 Harrison make acknowledgement and execute any further deed  
 or indenture in writings as the said Richard Harrison or his  
 heirs or assigns shall devise for the further and better  
 assurance security & sure making the laws and promises  
 aforesaid unto him the said Richard Harrison his heirs and  
 assigns forever and further the said Benjamin Harrison to himself  
 his heirs doth promise and agree to satisfy the said Richard
