This Indenture made this fiftenth day of
 January one thousand eight hundred & nineteen, between James
 Dillard and Martha St Dillard his wife of Tusper County on the one
 part and Alexander P. Pete of Southampton County on the other
 part Witnesseth that the said James Dillard for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of fourteen hundred dollars with lawful
 interest from the first day of January one thousand eight hundred
 and seventeen paid him by the said Alexander P. Pete half and
 leg these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Alexander P. Pete of certain tract or parcel of land lying
 being in the County of Southampton containing twenty five
 acres by the same more or less, (it being the land allotted to
 the above named Martha St Dillard as her proportion of her
 Father's land, and bounded as express in the Commissioners
 report who divided the land of Thomas Pectolles among
 his children, reference being thereunto had will more
 fully appear) to have and to hold possess and enjoy the
 said tract or parcel of land unto him the said Alexander P. Pete
 his heirs and assigns forever, and the said James Dillard
 and Martha St Dillard doth hereby agree to warrant and defend
 unto the said Alexander P. Pete a good and lawful title in fee
 simple in and to the said tract or parcel of land against
 themselves their heirs and against all and every other
 person or persons whomsoever for writing whereof the said
 James Dillard and Martha St Dillard his wife have
 hereto set their hands & affixed their seals the day and
 date above written
