 that the said Edwin Barnes of July this present for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Two hundred dollars current money of Virginia to them  
 in hand paid by the said Pearly Barnes the receipt of which they the  
 said Edwin Barnes and Suley his wife doth hereby acknowledge  
 hath bargained, sold, aliened and confirmed and so by their presents  
 bargain, sell aliened and confirmed unto the said Pearly Barnes a  
 certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the  
 County of Southampton containing by estimation seventy five acres  
 by the same more or less and bounded on the east by the land  
 of John Shipps dec'd and on the west north and south by the land  
 of John Barkham, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim  
 property and demand whatsoever of them of the said Edwin Barnes  
 and Suley his wife in and to the same to have and to hold  
 the said tract or parcel of land (and premises with appurtenances  
 unto the said Pearly Barnes his heirs and assigns forever and  
 the said Edwin Barnes and Suley his wife the said tract or  
 parcel of land and premises to the said Pearly Barnes his  
 heirs and assigns against them the said Edwin Barnes and  
 Suley his wife and their heirs and against all other persons.
