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This Indenture made this 9th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between Thomas Ellis Brooks & his wife Polly Brock of Southampton County State of Virginia of the one part and James Blithe of the county and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Ellis Brooks and his wife Polly Brock for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Two hundred dollars current money of Virginia by the said James Blithe to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they the said Thomas E. Brooks and Polly Brock do hereby acknowledge and thereunto acquit and discharge the said James Blithe his heirs & assigns forever, and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied, contented and paid, they the said Thomas E. Brooks and Polly Brock have granted bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released, set over, delivered and confirmed and by this present do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, release, set over, deliver and confirm unto the said James Blithe the wife to his heirs and assigns forever all their right, title, interest, claim or demand, or that of their ancestors, messuage, tract and parcel of land whereon the said Thomas E. Brooks & Polly his wife now lives, situate lying and being in Southampton County aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a white oak a corner then in Thomas Sathers land Senniah Colles line, then along the Sth part of the line to a branch in Sigs Brooks line, and down the said branch along the said Brooks line to a corner in John Brookes line then along the said John Brookes line to a corner in Senniah Colles line, then along the said Colles line to a corner in Senniah Colles and Peter Sathers line then along Sathers line to the beginning, containing thirty seven acres be the same more or less with all woods, way, water, water courses, bog grounds, pastures, orchards, profits, commodities, benefittments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining; and all reversion or reversions, rents, profits and all the estate right title interest claim or demand of them the said Thomas E. Brooks and Polly Brock of it, and of the same and every part and parcel thereof so have law to hold the said plantation, messuage, tract and parcel of thirty seven acres of land and premises with all and every other granted premises unto him the said James Blithe and to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use of him the said James Blithe and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas E. Brooks and Polly his wife by themselves their heirs executors and assigns and assigns the said plantation, messuage, tract and parcel of thirty seven acres of land and premises with all and every other granted premises as aforesaid unto him the said James Blithe his heirs and assigns forever against them the said Thomas E. Brooks and Polly Brock their heirs executors and assigns and against all manner of persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof, shall and will warrant & defend by their presents or assigns whosoever they the said Thomas E. Brooks & Polly his wife have heretofore set their hands and affixed their seals, signed sealed and delivered in presence of
