This Indenture made and entered into this twenty third day of
November in the year one thousand eight hundred & thirteen
Between Elizabeth Turner of the County of Southampton State of
Virginia of the one part and Richmond Cobb of the County of State
of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Elizabeth
Turner for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars
to her in hand well and truly paid by the said Richmond Cobb
before the writing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
truly acknowledged hath granted, bargained and sold by these
presents doth give, bargain and sell unto the said Richmond Cobb
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by
estimation sixty eight acres to the same more or less bounded
by the lands of Edwin Best Lazarus Cobb and also by James D.
Mayerburgs mill pond it being the tract of lands devised by
one Unapwood by his last will and testament to the aforesaid
Elizabeth Turner to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or
parcel of land to the only proper use and behoof of him the
said Richmond Cobb his heirs and assigns forever to the said Elizabeth
Turner for herself her heirs executors and assigns the right title to
the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Richmond Cobb his heirs
& assigns against the claim of herself or against the claim of herself or
against the claim or claims of any other person or persons whatsoever shall
and will forever warrant & defend by them presents to wit that
the said Elizabeth Turner hath hereunto set her hand & affixed her
