part and John Turner and Melly Turner his wife of the other part
Witnesseth that the said John Turner his wife for and in consideration of the
true Natural Love and affection that they bear for their children above
mentioned and more especially for the sum of one Dollar to them in hand
paid at the sealing and delivery of this present do give and grant
and by these presents truth given grantees unto the said John Rowe
and Elisha Rowe to them and to their heirs forever and to all
property to wit one loom one Bed and furniture one chest one dish
One plate together with all the property that was the said Melly
before her indenture with the said John Turner to them and their
heirs forever and that they enjoy this property equally between them
and the said John Turner and Melly his wife doth by these presents
covenant and grant to and with the said John Rowe and Elisha
Rowe and their heirs that they have quit all claim that have or ever
had to the said property in witness whereof the said John Turner
and Melly his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed
their Seals this day and date above written
