This Indenture made this twenty second day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty by and between James
Dillard executor of the last will and testament of Richmond Dillard late of
Southampton County deceased of the one part and Jesse Parker of the other part
Witnesseth that the said James Dillard was as aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of four hundred and thirty eight dollars to him the said James
Dillard in hand paid by the said Jesse Parker at and before the making
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by
the said James Dillard who as aforesaid hath granted bargained sold aliened
and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and
confirm unto the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns forever one certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in the county of
Southampton aforesaid and in the town district of Northway Parish
containing by estimation fifty eight and a half acres more or less the
being all that well known tract or parcel of land which the above named
Richmond Dillard purchased from Carr Darden as appears
by a deed duly executed by the said Carr Darden and through his
wife for the same which deed is duly proved and recorded in the court
of Southampton County aforesaid to have and to hold the said barg-
ained premises with all and singular the rents issues profits emoluments
and appurtenances out of the same in manner granting or conveying
or to the same in anywise belonging to him the said Jesse
Parker
