This Indenture made this 3^d day of May in the year one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty between John D. Pond and Patsy
 D. Pond his wife of the county of Halifax of the one part
 and Henry Smith and Anselm P. Smith both of the county
 of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that for and
 in consideration of the sum of five thousand one hundred &
 fifty Dollars dollars that the said John D. and Patsy D.
 Pond have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell to the said Henry and Anselm
 P. Smith his tracts of land lying in Southampton county and State of
 Virginia one suppose to contain about twenty four thousand acres and
 the other suppose to contain about four hundred acres being the lands
 allotted to the said Patsy D. Pond as her dower then the said John
 and Patsy D. Pond further bargain and sell all the dower negro
 of her the said Patsy (a list of whose names is hereto subjoined
 to them the said Henry and Anselm P. Smith together with all
 every right title interest property claim and demand of them the said
 John D. and Patsy D. Pond of or in or to the said lands and negro
 whether at law or in equity To Have and to hold the said lands
 and negro to them the said Henry and Anselm P. Smith and their
 heirs during the lives of them the said John and Patsy D. Pond
 for themselves and their heirs to the said Henry and Anselm P.
 Smith and their heirs the title to the said lands and negro as warrant
 and defend against the rightful claim title or demand of all persons
 claiming through or by them the said John and Patsy D. Pond
 whereof they the said John and Patsy have heretofore been seized
 and since the day and year first above written Sealed Sealed and
