This Indenture made and entered into this twenty third day of July in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Archibald Williford of one part and Edwin Williford of the other part Witnesses that the said Archibald Williford for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty three Dollars and thirty three cents to him in hand paid by the said Edwin Williford at or before the sealing and delivering of these premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these premises doth grant bargain and sell all and enfeoff and confirm to the said Edwin Williford and his heirs assigns forever all his right title interest claim and demand of in or to a certain tract or parcel of land (which Johnson Williford did seized and possess in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and thirty two acres with same more or less and bounded by the lands of Pyra Harvey on the North and West and the lands of Joshua Dutton on the South and east together with all true and undivided profits Commodities advantages Emoluments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging in any wise appertaining and also all the reversions & reversionary demands and remainders right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Archibald Williford his heirs &c. of in or to the said premises or any part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Edwin Williford his heirs and assigns forever and the said Archibald Williford his heirs the premises above mentioned and every part thereof unto the said Edwin Williford his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these premises In witness whereof the said Archibald Williford hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and first above written Signed Sealed and acknowledged in the presence of William Holliman
