This Indenture made and entered into this the nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Jacob Bailey of the County of Southampton State of Virginia and in the latter district of Saint Lukes Parish of the one part and Willis Jordan of the same County State and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Bailey for and in consideration of the sum of ~~five~~ dollars of annuum hath leased and let and by these presents doth lease let and rent unto him the said Willis Jordan a certain tract or plantation of Land situate being the plantation whereon him the said Willis Jordan now lives and to be bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at the Swamp and the road leading from Monroe to Vicks Chappell thence along said road to the first Branch thence up the various courses of said Branch to where the path crosses leading from said Bailey to John Whitfield thence along the said paths to William Vicks line at the corner of said Whitfield's fence thence by the said Whitfield's fence to the said Vicks line again thence by Vicks line to the said Swamp thence by the various courses of the run of said Swamp to the said road the beginning to have and to hold the within premises for the full term of five years by paying the above said said sum of Twenty five dollars annuum unto him the said Jacob Bailey or his heirs Executors administrators or assigns in the manner and form following that is to say the above said sum of Twenty five dollars to be paid annually at the expiration of each year and the said Willis Jordan by these presents for him self his heirs or assigns doth agree and obliges himself or either of them to put or cause to be put the said plantation under a good and sufficient fence for the keeping out beasts and to keep and return at the same keeping out beasts and to keep and return at the same at the expiration of the above said term of five years commencing the date first above written and ending the 31st day of Decr
