Know All men by these presents that I the said John Butts of the County of Southampton  
 do hereby certify that on the 20th day of April in the Year of our Lord  
 Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty one before me George Gentry Esqr  
 of the County of Southampton one of the Justices of the Peace and James  
 Rochelle of the County of Southampton one of the other Justices of the Peace that whereas  
 the said Jacob Vick by his last will and Testament which is duly proved  
 and recorded in the County Court of Southampton devised his Land adjoining  
 the Town of Jerusalem to be sold and conveyed by his executor either together or  
 separately either at public sale or private sale and on such terms as they should judge best  
 And whereas the said George the only acting Executor of the said Jacob Vick did the  
 other Executor named in the will refusing to qualify by virtue of his said will and  
 to take the aforesaid Land adjoining the Town of Jerusalem and a certain lot of land  
 that became the purchaser thereof And the said William Hart by his last will  
 and Testament which is also duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton devised  
 the said Land to his nephew William P Hart who sold a part thereof to William  
 B Gordon and James Rochelle by the following boundaries to wit Beginning  
 at the back part of the Lot belonging to the estate of Henry Morgan and then and oak  
 tree thence a straight line to a large gum standing on the Branch near James  
 Millers line thence the said James Millers line to where it strikes the road  
 thence up the road to Golden Kitchen lot in the plan of the Town of Jerusalem  
 thence along Golden Kitchen's line to the line of the late Henry Morgan and thence  
 the said Henry's line to the beginning reference being had to the record of said
