This Indenture made and entered into this day of ^{meeting} ~~meeting~~ our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between John Derry of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Samuel Derry of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars in hand paid to the receipt whereof the said Samuel Derry and his heirs forever a certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows on the north by the three creeks on the west by the lands of Jesse Holt on the south by the lands of John Derry and on the east by the lands of Samuel Derry including all the land between the road leading immediately from Jerusalem to Telford which I bought of John B. Hunt containing fifty acres by estimation it be the same more or less with all the appurtenances and benefits thereto belonging To have and to hold unto the said Samuel Derry and his heirs forever to which said the said John Derry do warrant and defend the title to the said Samuel and his heirs forever against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever. Canfield Marshal had in pursuance of a decree of the Superior Court of Chancery for the District aforesaid pronounced on the 23rd day of January in the case of Thomas Applewhite Collier vs. James Adam of John A. Wilkinson vs. Margaret & others against Henry Briggs with the will annexed of John A. Wilkinson & others and of a sale made by him by virtue of said decree by public auction of the land named in said decree at which the said Robert Gordon became the purchaser for the sum of one hundred and Ten Dollars and in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and Ten Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert Gordon before the said Robert Gordon and by these presents hath given grant bargain and sold aliened released conveyed and confirmed unto the said Robert Gordon his heirs and assigns the said tract or parcel of land aforesaid situated in the County of Southampton adjoining the lands belonging to the Estate of Samuel Derry and others containing eighty three acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the buildings in and upon the same situate
