 J. Army Luke, Jacob, Dick, Polly, Tom, Susan, Mercy, Jane, Andrew and Barbara also all
 her dower interest in a certain tract of Land known as follow by the Great Key on the East
 Newton's Lands on the South, William Whitehead's land on the West and Whitehead's
 Taylor's Land on the North. It is here and to hold to the said William Blon in him or his
 agent upon that special trust nevertheless that if the said Mary Ann Kirby shall be
 permitted to remain in peaceable and quiet possession of said property above conveyed and if
 she said Harper be likely to be forced to pay the said debt or any part thereof, to which he stands bound
 security, or in case some unforeseen circumstance shall render necessary for him to sell the property
